PUBLIC HEARING FOR ZONING AMENDMENT 2017-01

The public hearing was called to order at 6:30pm by Chairman Irene McMullen with Trustees Andy Bushman and Jim McCaskey and Fiscal Officer Judy Toth present. The Chairman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mrs. McMullen advised that the legal notice was published on August 10, 2017 and the amendment was available for the public to review between August 10th and August 22nd. Andy Bushman moved and Jim McCaskey seconded to waive the reading of the legal notice, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. Mr. Bushman read the recommendations of the Munson Township Zoning Commission and the recommendations of the Geauga County Planning Commission. Mr. Bushman referenced the changes that were made-in various sections for clarification, and reviewed amendments to Section 102, Purpose of Zoning Amendment and Section 901, Wireless Telecommunications Towers and Facilities. Mrs. McMullen asked for public comment. There was none. She asked if the Board wished any further discussion. As there was none, the Trustees signed Exhibit A-1.

Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to close the public hearing at 7:36pm, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

REGULAR MEETING

Mrs. McMullen opened the regular meeting at 7:36pm. The Trustees signed warrants 15154-15178 dated August 22, 25, and 31, 2017 totaling \$131,813.20, EFT Vouchers 327-332 and 334-335 for the 8/25/2017 bi-weekly payroll in the amount of \$8,723.06, and warrant 1259 for \$5,538 to transfer EMS collections from the lockbox.

CEMETERY DEED

The Board signed a deed to James P. and Bobbie Lee Nolan for Fowlers Mill II Cemetery, Lot 98, Grave 8.

MINUTES

Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to approve the August 8, 2017 minutes, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment

FIRE DEPARTMENT/FIRE & EMS ADMINISTRATOR MARK LYNN

Administrator Lynn reported that Engine 4022 would be back in service by the end of the week. He invited the Board to view a demonstration of automatic load cots by Striker on August 28th at 9am. The fire department was asked to put the ladder truck out on Thursday for the funeral procession of a young cancer victim that will pass the fire station. This was at the request of the Hambden Fire Department, which had adopted the boy's cause. He was able to find one company to purchase the old SCBA equipment, and asked for authorization to sell it for \$2,000. Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to authorize Mark Lynn to sell the SCBA's up to 16 units to the vendor of his choice, SCBA Sales and Rental Company, for \$2,000, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

ROAD REPORT/SUPERINTENDENT JIM TEICHMAN

The Board asked the road superintendent if he had received the email from the county engineer's office regarding placement of the speed limit signs on Legend Creek Drive. Mr. Teichman reported that All-Ways Flasher will be out of business by the end of the month. The Township will need to find a new vendor for signs and flashers. Prospective employee Ross McKinstry passed his background checks and physical and had his temporary CDL. Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to hire Ross McKinstry, as presented, effective Tuesday, September 5, 2017 at \$17 per hour, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. Mr. Teichman submitted a quote from Servisoft to perform the yearly maintenance on the fire department water softener. Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to accept the Servisoft quote as presented, up to \$150, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

FOWLERS MILL ROAD MILLINGS

The Trustees signed letters authorizing the trench millings from the Fowlers Mill Road Project to go to Shepp Electric at 12069 Mayfield Road and the road surface millings to go to Alpine Valley at 10620 Mayfield Road. The letters were also signed by a representative from each entity.

SHERMAN ROAD RIGHT OF WAY

The Trustees signed a letter requesting the county engineer to stake the right-of-way on Sherman Road at the southeast corner of Heath and Sherman for a culvert pipe.

RESOLUTION 2017-30/ZONING AMENDMENT 2017-01

Resolution 2017-30 was made by Andy Bushman and seconded by Jim McCaskey to approve Zoning Amendment 2017-01, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

ZONING FEES

The Board reviewed an amended zoning fee schedule which will increase the base fee for an accessory building from \$50 to \$75. Jim McCaskey moved and Andy Bushman seconded to accept the Munson Township zoning fee schedule, as presented, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. RECYCLING AREA

The Geauga Trumbull Solid Waste Management District approved \$1,100 for the pipe and catch basin for the new recycling area. They will require an invoice from the Township before making payment. Mr. McCaskey asked Mr. Teichman to move forward with the project if none of the trees are brown bat habitats.

TOWN HALL LANDSCAPING

The Trustees agreed with Mr. Bushman's suggestion that perennials from the township parks be used to landscape the town hall. Mr. McCaskey agreed to view the plants and coordinate the project.

KOELLIKER MEMORIAL

The Board set September 26th, prior to the Trustees meeting, as a tentative date for the Koelliker memorial dedication. Mr. Bushman will contact the family for confirmation.

RESOLUTION 2017-31/FUND TRANSFER

Resolution 2017-31 was made by Jim McCaskey and seconded by Andy Bushman for within fund transfers in the General, Motor Vehicle, Gasoline Tax, Road and Bridge, and Fire Operating and Apparatus Funds in the Permanent Appropriation, with a unanimous vote. RESOLUTION 2017-32/AMOUNTS AND RATES

BALL FIELD WEED CONTROL

Superintendent Teichman submitted a quote from P. Ianiro for a winterization weed control application for the six township ball fields.
