The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Chairman Jim McCaskey with Trustees Irene McMullen and Andy Bushman and Fiscal Officer Judy Toth present. The Chairman led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Board signed EFT Vouchers 465-472 for the 12/13/19 bi-weekly payroll and Warrants 17020-17050 dated 12/10/19 for \$23,387.45.

CEMETERY DEED

The Board signed a deed to Ronald F. and Penny J. Wolfe for Maple Hill III Cemetery, Lot 329, Grave 6.

MINUTES

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to approve the minutes of November 12, 2019, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to approve the minutes of November 25, 2019, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to approve the minutes of November 26, 2019. Roll call vote: Mrs. McMullen, yes; Mr. Bushman, yes; Mr. McCaskey, abstain. Motion carried.

SENIOR PROJECT/DUGOUT BENCH

Members of the Chardon Baseball Team were present to request permission to construct a new bench for the dugout at the Don Zambory Field, the home field for the Chardon High School Baseball Team, as a senior project. Spokesperson Ryan Bluemmel thanked the Trustees for the use of the field and presented a proposal to construct a 30 ft. moveable bench at no cost to the Township. They will add helmet cubbies and a bat rack if they raise enough money. Mr. Bushman advised that the Park Board was aware of their project, and asked them to attend the next Park Board meeting to present their plans.

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to approve the Chardon Baseball Team's proposal to construct dugout benches, helmet cubbies and a bat rack, and to donate them to the Township, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident Joe Bastulli addressed the Board regarding the Bethlehem Hills light display. He disputed that a variance was not required for the ancillary use of the golf course property, and that the manor house property was included in the conditional use. He reviewed the history of the ownership of the manor house property, and asked the Board to intervene.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT/FIRE TRUSTEE RICH FERLIN

Mr. Ferlin was present at the request of Chief Vatty to give the fire report. The Fire Department will prepare an estimate to replace the fluorescent lighting at the fire department with LED bulbs to save on electricity. He asked the Trustees to consider the NOPEC grant for funding. The Boy Scout trailer has tags through the end of the year. The Fire Department is looking into changing their 501c4 status to 501c3, and he asked the Trustees to take responsibility for the trailer and to sponsor the Boy Scouts for one year until they can make the change. Their insurance company agreed to insure the trailer on a temporary basis, but will not continue the coverage. The 501c4 status limits how the Fire Department may accept and use donations. Mr. Bushman agreed to follow up with the Boy Scout troop and the Fire Department. The Fire Department's new software will have enhanced incident reporting. They restored the lost data and purchased virus protection for the computers. He asked the Township to set aside the funds from the sale of the squad and heavy rescue vehicle. Mrs. Toth advised she placed the funds in a capital equipment line item in the temporary appropriation. All agreed to use the funds toward the first lease payment in April.

ROAD REPORT/KIRK WALKER

Superintendent Walker submitted an estimate to remove a leaning tree at the park; however, the contractor will not be able to do the job until spring. Mr. McCaskey asked him to get a quote to have the tree removed as soon as possible. Mr. Walker submitted a proposal from Burton Sheet Metal to inspect and clean the town hall and fire department furnaces and air conditioning units at a cost of \$20 per unit. There will be no charge for the two newest units, as they are under a first year warranty.

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to contract with Burton Sheet Metal at \$20 per unit not to exceed \$100, effective January 1, 2020, for servicing the furnaces and air conditioning units, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

ROAD REPORT (continued)

Mr. Walker spoke with the neighboring property owner regarding installing a shorter fence and filtering with trees, and will get an agreement in writing. He marked the property line with pins. The neighbor has noticed a difference since the fire department began backing into the parking spaces. The Township will take down all of the trees. Some of the trees may be on the neighbor's property. Mr. Walker will get new quotes for an 8-foot fence and suggested planting trees on the hillside to filter headlights. The county building department will review the blueprints for the maintenance lunchroom renovations. The box is being made for the new truck.

SPEED LIMITS/BEAN & ROCKHAVEN

The County Engineer completed a speed study and will not support a reduction in the speed limit on Bean or Rockhaven.

PLANNING COMMISSION STEERING COMMITTEE

The Planning Commission would like two volunteers from each community to serve on a steering committee, one Trustee and a resident, who will be able to commit to four out of five meetings. The county is working on a joint general and economic plan and needs a response by January 1. The Board will reach out to candidates in the community for a decision at the next meeting.

CENSUS WORKERS

A flyer advertising for census workers to begin in the spring will be placed on the bulletin board. Pay is \$17 per hour.

TOWN HALL 2020 CLEANING CONTRACT

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to contract with Custodial Services and Supply for once a week cleaning at \$550 per month, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 2019-42/SHERIFF'S CONTRACT

Resolution 2019-42 was made by Irene McMullen and seconded by Andy Bushman to contact with the Geauga County Sheriff's Department for police protection, as written, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

JANUARY ORGANIZATIONAL MEETING

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to hold a special meeting on Thursday, January 2, 2020 for organizational purposes, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

FORMAL COMPLAINT RE ZONING

Mr. McCaskey asked the Board to address a formal complaint against the zoning decision for the Bethlehem Hills lighting display. Mrs. McMullen asked for time to discuss this with the assistant prosecutor. Mr. McCaskey believed the matter should go before the Board of Zoning Appeals and be addressed, so that the Township could move forward. The assistant prosecutor will be asked to attend an executive session at the December 30 meeting.

SEARCHABLE MINUTES

Mr. McCaskey suggested placing the minutes for each year in a searchable document on the web page. Mrs. Toth agreed to look into this and report to the Board.

MUNSON LAND USE STUDY

Mr. McCaskey advised that the last revision to the Munson Land Use Study was in August 2010.

BASEBALL

The Board discussed Stewart Landies' request to place the Chardon High School logo on the dugouts. Mr. Bushman will work with him on the design. He reported that the baseball team boosters have scheduled a meeting the second week in January to discuss what they would like to propose to the Township.

HANDICAP RESTROOM/MUNSON TOWNSHIP PARK

Mr. Bushman will have proposals for two options, one from the Department on Aging and the second from Enzoco Homes. Mr. McCaskey suggested completing the work before spring.

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ASSISTANT FISCAL OFFICER

Mr. McCaskey attended a meeting at the county offices with state auditor Keith Faber. Mr. Faber advised that the Township would need to hire the newly elected fiscal officer in order to give him access to the UAN computer and a township email, and to be bonded. He should not be permitted to donate his time or work for a small stipend. The Board will discuss hiring Mr. Ray during the executive session.

OHIO CHECKBOOK INITIATIVE

The Board will discuss the State Auditor's Ohio Checkbook initiative at the next meeting to give Mr. Bushman time to address his objections with the state auditor's local liaison.

ACH LIMITS

The State Auditor stressed that precautions be put in place for ACH bank transactions. Mrs. Toth advised that she had an agreement with Middlefield Bank that set the limit and that they would contact her if a transaction exceeded the limit. She asked if the Board would like to set the limit.

NOVEMBER MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT

Irene McMullen moved and Andy Bushman seconded to accept the Fiscal Officer's monthly financial report for November, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 2019-39/2020 TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION

Resolution 2019-39 was made by Irene McMullen and seconded by Andy Bushman to approve the 2020 Temporary Appropriation for \$1,905,037 through March 31, 2020, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

Mrs. Toth reviewed where she placed capital funds, noted that most of the funding was for a three-month period with the exception of line items where she traditionally created a purchase order for the entire year, and advised that she included \$9,000 in a contingency line item in the General Fund. Funds may not be spent from the contingency line item, but may be moved in the event they are needed.

RESOLUTION 2019-40/FUND CERTIFICATION AND DE-CERTIFICATION

Resolution 2019-40 was made by Andy Bushman and seconded by Irene McMullen to request the Budget Commission to increase the revenues in the General Fund, Gasoline Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Fund, Zoning Fund, Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, and Ambulance and Emergency Medical Fund; reduce the revenues in the Cemetery Fund; and to reduce the Permanent Appropriation in the Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Fund, and Cemetery Fund, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. [The resolution in its entirety is included on a separate page as part of the minutes.]

PERFORMANCE AUDIT

Mr. McCaskey discussed an opportunity from the state auditor for a performance audit. Townships may realize up to a 25-1 return if they follow all of the suggestions. He recommended setting up a preliminary meeting.

COMMUNITY ROOM RENTAL

The Board addressed a request to waive or reduce the rental fees for a gathering on January 4, 2020 for 100 persons, made by a Munson resident, and determined that the fees should be charged.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident Dawn Bastulli reviewed how she and her husband became aware of the Bethlehem Hills lighting display, what processes they followed to get information, the expenses they have incurred, and the negative impact the pulsating lights and the influx of persons attending the event have had on her family. She raised several questions about zoning and if the proceeds from the event were used as promised.

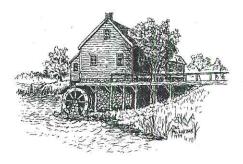
