Chairman Andy Bushman called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, with Trustees Jim McCaskey and Irene McMullen and Fiscal Officer Todd Ray present. Mr. Bushman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### **Cemetery Deeds**

Mr. Bushman stated that the Trustees had one cemetery deed to sign. Trustees signed deed #5-342 for Stacey L. Johnson, Fowlers Mill Cemetery, section 2, lot 345, grave 11.

Mr. Bushman stated that Trustees have warrants to sign: warrant numbers 18423 through 18457 dated 12/14/21, totaling \$55,485.38, along with the December 10, 2021, bi-weekly payroll EFT vouchers 308 through 315, totaling \$9,242.70 were signed by the Trustees.

Jim McCaskey moved to approve the minutes of Trustees Regular meeting Tuesday, November 23. Irene McMullen seconded. Motion carried, with a unanimous vote, with Mr. McCaskey abstaining. Jim McCaskey moved to approve the minutes of Trustees Special meeting Thursday, December 2. Irene McMullen seconded. Motion carried, with a unanimous vote, with Ms. McMullen abstaining.

#### **Public Comment**

Chair Andy Bushman called for any public comment from meeting attendees. No one in attendance offered any comment.

#### **FIRE DEPARTMENT**

Assistant Fire Chief Brian Gray reported that the Fire Department is on pace to respond to 1400 emergency call in 2021, a 15% increase in call volume. He noted that there were some call created by the recent high winds that blew through the Township.

Assistant Chief Gray reported that the new squad is scheduled to be finished on December 20, and the Department will have it delivered to the Township. The Trustees discussed the payment for the new squad.

Jim McCaskey moved to authorize Chair Andy Bushman to sign for the loan with Geauga Credit Union for the purchase of a new squad from RSVP Incorporated, not to exceed \$260,000. Irene McMullen seconded the motion. With a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

Geauga Credit Union will provide a check for the exact amount of the ambulance when it is delivered. The Township will make lease-to-purchase payments annually on a schedule, with the first payment due one year from delivery.

The Trustees discussed the process for disposal of the old squad. The estimated value of the old squad is greater than \$2,500, and a sealed- bid process will be followed to determine the buyer.

#### **ROAD DEPARTMENT**

Road Superintendent Kirk Walker reported that the Road Department crew has started some preliminary demolition work on the Road Maintenance Building renovation project, removing drywall. Mr. Walker has been getting quotes on the required beam that is part of the project. Mr. McCaskey asked that the record reflect that he is aware that his brother was contacted and submitted a quote for the beam, but that Jim has not had any contact with his brother nor discussed the matter in any way.

#### **TOWNSHIP BUSINESS**

#### Ohio Township Association Winter Conference

Jim McCaskey moved to allow Munson's elected officials to attend the Ohio Township Association Winter Conference January 26 through the 28<sup>th</sup>, with the Township covering all related expenses for registration, travel, meals, and lodging. Irene McMullen seconded. Motion carried, with a unanimous vote.

#### Vacating Hospital Drive

Mr. McCaskey reported that he had been exploring the issue with the County Engineer and he felt that it made sense, but there were plenty of questions to resolve. The Trustees understand that there have been administrative changes at UH Geauga, and so the issue has stalled for the time being. Andy Bushman indicated that he would reach out to the new administrator in the new year to resume the discussion.

#### **Sherman Road Project**

Mr. McCaskey noted that there has been no progress on the plans for improving a section of Sherman Road next summer. He spoke with the county engineer assigned to the project, who is waiting for guidance from the Trustees on the scope and section that road to be improved. The Trustees understand that the design work must meet a minimum requirement of safety point to qualify for the \$200,000 OPWC grant funds that were awarded to the Township for this project. Mr. McCaskey pointed out that costs are going up, and will likely exceed the preliminary estimate of \$600,000 and could go as high as \$800,000. Fiscal Officer Todd Ray will update the numbers on available funds in Township accounts to use as local match for the OPWC grant. Trustees will have to give direction to the engineer early in 2022 so that drawings and a bid package can be prepared.

#### **Town Hall Cleaning Contract**

Jim McCaskey moved to approve renewing the cleaning contract for the Town Hall for 2022, with the same vendor (Custodial Services and Supply) and no increase (\$550/month). Irene McMullen seconded. Motion carried, with a unanimous vote.

#### NOPEC Community Sponsorship Program

Irene McMullen moved to authorize Irene to sign the required paperwork to enroll Munson in the 2022 NOPEC Community Sponsorship Program in the amount of \$1500. Jim McCaskey seconded. Motion carried with a unanimous vote.

#### **Elected Official's Compensation**

Jim McCaskey moved and Irene McMullen seconded that for 2022, the Trustees will be compensated by the salary method and receive the maximum amount allowable by the Ohio Revised Code, equal to the maximum amount that could be received annually by a Trustee if he or she were to be paid on a per diem basis, and payable in twelve equal monthly payments, Roll call vote: Mr. McCaskey and Ms. McMullen, yes; Mr. Bushman, no. Motion carried. Mr. McCaskey moved and Irene McMullen seconded to offer health insurance, dental insurance, and the highest amount available of life insurance under the Township life insurance policy up to \$50,000 for a newly elected or appointed Township Trustee or Fiscal Officer. Roll call vote: Ms. McMullen, yes; Mr. McCaskey, yes; Mr. Bushman, no. Motion carried.

#### FISCAL OFFICER

#### RESOLUTION 2021-43/2022 TEMPORARY APPROPRIATION

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-43 was made by Jim McCaskey and seconded by Irene McMullen to approve the 2022 Temporary Appropriation for \$2,141,821 through March 31, 2022, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

#### RESOLUTION 2021-44 / Within Fund Transfer

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-44 was made by Ms. McMullen and seconded by Mr. McCaskey, that the 2021 Permanent Appropriation be amended by a set of within-fund transfers in the General Fund; with a unanimous vote, the motion carried. #### RESOLUTION 2021-45/Fund Certification and Appropriations

A motion to approve Resolution 2021-45 was made by Jim McCaskey and seconded by Irene McMullen to request the Budget Commission to increase the revenues in the General Fund, Motor Vehicle tax Fund, Gasoline Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Fund, Cemetery Fund, Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, and; reduce the permanent appropriations in the Road and Bridge Fund and Permissive Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, and to increase the Permanent Appropriation in the Ambulance and Emergency Medical Fund, with a unanimous vote.
