PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2014 BUDGET

The public hearing was called to order at 6:30pm by Chairman Andy Bushman, with Trustees Todd Ray and Irene McMullen and Fiscal officer Judy Toth present. The Chairman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Trustees reviewed the budget items and initialed the changes.

Todd Ray moved and Irene McMullen seconded to close the public hearing for the 2014 Budget at 6:37pm, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting was called to order at 6:38pm by Chairman Andy Bushman. Warrants 11455-11464 dated 7/5/13 totaling \$8,211.48 and EFT Vouchers 246-256 for the 7/5/13 biweekly payroll in the amount of \$10,173.43 were signed between meetings. Warrants 11465-11495 dated 7/9/13 totaling \$14,489.58 and Warrant 1160 dated 7/9/13 in the amount of \$21,180.89 to transfer EMS collections from the lockbox to the primary account, were signed. Correspondence was on the table.

MINUTES

Todd Ray moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the minutes of June 25, 2013 as written, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

JUNE FISCAL REPORT

Todd Ray moved and Irene McMullen seconded to accept the fiscal officer's monthly financial report for June, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

TOWN HALL PROJECT

Architect Hank Penttila updated the trustees on the progress of the town hall project. Despite the heavy rain, Enzoco Homes has moved forward admirably well. The foundation has been poured. They have not experienced problems except for one area of the parking lot where the topsoil is deeper than anticipated. Construction Manager Enzo Perfetto continued the report. The projected cost for excavation was \$106,000 and is right on target. The pipe was reworked to the septic lines to provide more pitch. Thus far there have been no major overruns. The retention area was raised and reconfigured due to a higher water table than was anticipated. There were no issues with the main drive off Sherman Road. The weather has not been favorable, but the project is in good shape and is ahead of schedule. Concrete and framing will be next. The eastern portion of the parking lot where topsoil was uncovered needs to be addressed. He gave the trustees two options - remove one foot of topsoil and replace it with premium fill at a cost of \$7,000, or use stockpiled crushed asphalt from the road department yard to provide a base at a cost of \$4,150. The contractor confirmed that the asphalt would provide a good base if properly compacted and applied in thin layers. The road department will use the excavated topsoil for the cemetery. Either option will be an additional cost and will require a change order.

Todd Ray moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the change order to site work, removing soil and adding asphalt grindings to be compacted for the base, in the amount of \$4,150, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. The Trustees signed the change order. The architect met with office manager Paula Friebertshauser and the township's IT advisor Matt Moormeier to discuss locations for telephones, computers, and audiovisual equipment. He will formally document the locations on a drawing and get prices for the drops. Ceiling projectors will be placed in the community room and in the trustees meeting room. The plans for the main reception area and caucus room were reviewed. Mrs. Friebertshauser recommended that one of the three doors into the caucus room be eliminated and that the double doors at the entrance to the community room be repositioned. She asked if a window could be added to allow the receptionist to see into the lobby, but was advised that this was not possible. She revisited an interior window wall for the trustees meeting room to allow more lighting into the office area, but the trustees were not in favor. Decisions will need to be made soon regarding how the various doors and entrances are to be keyed. Mr. Ray inquired about a remote locking system for the main door to the offices. Mrs. Friebertshauser advised that the copy machine will be placed next to the receptionist and the kitchen will no longer be needed for a workroom. She suggested using the space to store office supplies by adding additional shelves or cupboards. Mrs. McMullen wanted to replace the counters and sink. Mrs. Friebertshauser asked about replacing the floor and repainting the walls and was told it was not part of the contract. She inquired about renovating the zoning office. Mr. Bushman said the contract includes replacement of the ceiling tiles throughout, and insulation and new windows for the zoning office. The window wall will be repainted. Additional items would be a separate contract but could be done at the same time.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Resident Richard Germaine of 11469 Fowlers Mill Road asked the trustees for assistance with recurring water problems in his basement. He believed the problem to originate with the 12" drainpipe underneath Chippendale Court, the private road located next to his property. The drain also receives water from Nollwood Drive. He has a back flow device on his basement drain, but water still comes in. The Trustees suggested that the county engineer be contacted to do a watershed and pipe capacity study. Shane Hajjar was in attendance from the county engineer's office. He said it was a private drive and the county engineer had no authority. However, if the trustees make a written request the engineer's office will give its informal advice and guidance. He suggested that Mr. Germaine remove the downspouts from his footer drains.

FIRE PROOF FILES

Zoning inspector Tim Kearns requested \$1,100 to purchase two used legal fire proof files from A & G Office Furniture in Cleveland. The township will pick up the files.

Todd Ray moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the purchase of two four-drawer fire proof file cabinets not to exceed \$1,100 from A & G Office Furniture, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

FIRE REPORT

Fire Chief Mark Lynn reported on a garage fire at the site of the former nursing home on Rockhaven Road. They believed the fire to be weather related. Route 322 was closed for one hour due to downed power lines. The trustees received a copy of the letter from Cleveland Clinic thanking the fire department for their part in the eight-hour training. Cleveland Clinic plans to join MedEvac and Metro in helicopter response to accidents. Chief Lynn will attend a Fire Chief's conference next week and will not be able to attend the next trustees meeting. Residents are contacting the fire department to report that they are no longer eligible for the 3/6 ISO rating and are being charged higher insurance rates. Residents further than 5 miles from the fire station are being increased to a 9 rating. The chief has spoken with several insurance companies but has not been able to resolve this issue. He was also told that if he provides proof that we have automatic aid with other departments this may reduce the rating. He will have an opportunity to meet with ISO representatives at the conference. Mr. Bushman advised that many insurance companies are using other underwriters and are no longer following ISO ratings. The Chief said that the problem has become more apparent this year. He asked the trustees to refer any calls to him.

ROAD REPORT

Road Superintendent JimTeichman reported that he reviewed the specifications and estimates for the road projects. He discussed the materials necessary to construct a six foot retaining wall on Raintree Drive and requested \$2,500 for interlocking blocks from King Brothers in Bristolville. A compacting plate has been ordered for the backhoe. Work continues on reshaping the ditch on Sherman Road across from the Emmons property. A large stump five feet in diameter was removed and hauled to Scenic River where it will be burned. They are removing the sandy soil and replacing it with clay to create a six foot berm with a 2 foot down slope. He reported some storm damage and that the chipper broke down today.

Resolution 2013-29 was made by Todd Ray and seconded by Irene McMullen to request the budget commission to certify additional money received from inheritance tax in the amount of \$81,500 and to place it in various line items in the General Fund, and for within fund transfers in the General Fund and Road and Bridge Fund, with a unanimous vote.
