PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2017 BUDGET

The public hearing for the 2017 Budget was called to order at 6:30pm by Chairman Jim McCaskey with Trustees Andy Bushman and Irene McMullen and Fiscal Officer Judy Toth present. The Chairman led the Pledge of Allegiance. There was no public comment. Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to close the public hearing at 6:34pm. REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting convened at 6:34pm. The Trustees signed warrants 14163-14195 dated 6/28 and 6/30/16 totaling \$128,472.58 and EFT vouchers 658-662 for the 6/30/16 monthly payroll totaling \$6,905.51 and vouchers 668-677 for the 7/1/16 monthly payroll in the amount of \$10,047.53.

MINUTES

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the minutes of June 14, 2016, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

CEMETERY DEED

The Trustees signed a cemetery deed to Kimberly A. Fiucci, Maple Hill III Cemetery, Lot 346, Grave 3.

FIRE REPORT/CHIEF MARK LYNN

Chief Lynn reported the convex mirror was put up. The radios are being installed in the aerial platform truck. The department is well within the 500 call range.

ROAD REPORT/SUPERINTENDENT JIM TEICHMAN

Mr. Teichman requested \$1400 to McGill Septic for catch basins and grates and \$2,550 to CIR for excavation and installation for the Fowlers Mill Road project. He discussed the culvert work at Fowlers Mill and Sherman. For the Rockhaven and Wye resurfacing project, the gas line was dropped down, the last cross culvert installed, and the full depth repairs done. The preconstruction meeting will be scheduled as soon as the contracts are signed.

OLD FLAG POLE

The Fire Department measured the old flagpole. It is 31 feet tall, and a decision will need to be made whether the township personnel can move it.

ALPINE VALLEY RIGHT OF WAY

Mr. McCaskey's employees cleared a path through the right-of-way from the Alpine Valley parking lot to the Historic District. Signs will be put up to warn residents not to go off the path because there is poison ivy. Mr. McCaskey asked if the township had a load of grindings to stabilize the path. A question was raised whether the township is allowed to improve private property. McCaskey will talk with Alpine Valley and ask the prosecutor if the Township is allowed to place materials on private property. Pastor Roy Williams has offered to speak at the Bicentennial. The Township will contact him to accept his offer.
