






Scenic River Retreat Joint Efforts, Cooperation & Getting Things Done!

Constructing a 1.1 mile trail in a Township park takes the joint effort and cooperation of many individuals to get the job done. As with all projects of this type, there are many steps to the process that go on behind the scenes of which residents may not be aware. The Township's Park & Recreation Board, along with the Township Trustees, try to get the community involved and this project certainly did.







After receiving the appropriate approvals, the Township hired Sumner Creeks Contracting to construct the trail improvements. The construction began in the later part of July and was completed in August.

As one can see, there were many moving parts, but even more cooperation was needed to get this project off the ground. Funding requirements led to more joint efforts. The trail improvements were underwritten by a state "Nature Works" matching grant, and through the cooperation and involvement of the Foundation of Geauga Parks who provided the funding for the match to the Township. Munson Township is deeply grateful to the Foundation of Geauga Parks for the matching grant, the first awarded to a Township park from the foundation.

The Scenic River Retreat Trail embodies the true spirit of community cooperation. The Township is grateful for the trail improvements and would truly like to thank the all the parties involved in this project.

To celebrate, the Township hosted a Guided Trail Hike open house on October 5th.

From the Zoning Office



We realize that not all business owners may be aware of certain zoning regulations in the Township. In particular, Section 1201 which reads as follows:

No person shall change any use of land, a building, or a structure, nor locate, relocate, erect, construct, reconstruct, enlarge or structurally alter any building or structure within Munson Township without first obtaining a Zoning Certificate. No Zoning Certificate shall be issued unless the plans for the proposed building or structure or use of land fully comply with the provisions of this Resolution, unless the Zoning Inspector receives a written order from the Board of Zoning Appeals deciding an appeal, a variance or conditional use.

To clarify, when a new business is established or there is a change of use of any building or structures, the owner or new tenant must apply for a zoning certificate. The purpose of this is to ensure that the new business or change of use is permitted and in compliance with zoning, signage and the County Building Department. All of which in turn, ensures the health, safety and welfare of the Township.

Please do not hesitate to call with any questions or for clarification on any of the above. The Zoning Office hours are from 9:00am to 3:00pm Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays or by appointment.

Scholarship Program

Munson Township is offering a minimum of two scholarships for the 2020-21 school year. The Township's Scholarship Program was established in 2005. Road Department



Helpful information to help us get through the seasons ahead.

LEAVES - Leaves from residents' yards should not be raked or blown into the roadside ditch. Leaves plug the culverts, stopping the flow of water that leads to erosion and washouts of road edge berms, driveways, and sometimes roadways. The alternative is to compost the leaves and use the compost for flower beds and gardens next year.

<u>DRIVEWAYS</u> - New concrete or asphalt driveways are a great way to improve your property. If they are improperly installed, these driveway surfaces, especially at the adjoining road surface, in relation to finished height, may lead to many problems such as: water not pitched to flow to the ditch line and out into the road or berm, therefore causing a build-up in colder weather; and driveway ending height above the road edge may cause damage to snowplows and to the surface itself.

SNOW REMOVAL - Though prohibited by Ohio law, the practice of pushing snow across the roadway or out into the road and cul-de-sacs causing a hazard, still is a common practice by some. Please contact the responsible party at your residence and ask that this practice not continue.

Live Fire Burn Training

It has been nearly 25 years since the Munson Fire Department has hosted a Live Fire Burn Training. There were twenty personnel from Munson who partook in the event. The Chardon Fire Department participated with six personnel and brought a reserve engine for the drill in case it was needed. The Hambden Fire Department participated with four personnel and brought a backup engine to establish a draft site at the neighboring retention pond at Munson Industrial Plaza. Instructors were able to simulate over fifty fires for this prepared scenario. Thankfully there were

no injuries, no damage to any equipment and everyone had positive feedback and good spirits.

Everyone involved benefited from this training experience. It took a lot of dedication to pull off this event. It is very important to train together; we work together through mutual aid and auto aid quite regularly. Munson Fire Department ended the day with a family picnic that was enjoyed by all. Heaters:

- Look for a control feature that automatically shuts off the power if the heater falls over.
- Never leave a heater on when you are not in the room or when you go to sleep, and do not leave children or pets unattended around any heating source. Unplug the heater when you are not using it.
- Don't use an extension cord with an electric portable heater.

 The current to the heater could melt the cord and cause a fire.
- Don't plug more than one heating device into an outlet.
- Never use electric heaters near water as in your bathroom or near a water heater.
