The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by Chairman Jim McCaskey with Trustees Andy Bushman and Irene McMullen and Fiscal Officer Judy Toth present. The Chairman led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Trustees signed warrants 14568-14590 dated 11/29 and 11/30/16 totaling \$312,257.55, EFT Vouchers 891-901 for the 12/2/16 biweekly payroll totaling \$10,942.80, EFT Vouchers 881-885 for the 11/30/16 monthly payroll totaling \$6,887.93, and warrant 1240 in the amount of \$4,555.64 to transfer EMS collections from the lockbox.

CEMETERY DEEDS

The Trustees signed deeds to Robert F. Voss and Katherine A. Wheeler for Fowlers Mill II Cemetery, Lot 343, Graves 7 and 8; and Michaleen Basham for Maple Hill III Cemetery, Lot 329, Grave 11.

MINUTES

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve the minutes of October 11, 2016, as written, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Fowlers Mill Road Project

Resident Debbie Roche asked the Board what kind of meeting would be required for the public to ask questions and receive direct answers from the Trustees. Mr. Bushman said he would answer questions. Mr. McCaskey advised that the engineer's office was redoing the plans. When the plans are done, the Trustees will set up a workshop. Residents were concerned about further alterations or changes in the plans. Mrs. McMullen suggested that a date be set and word go out to the residents. Mr. McCaskey agreed to invite engineer Joe Cattell to attend the meeting. Resident Rich Ferlin told the Trustees that residents had raised a concern about driveway pipes and wanted to know why they were billed to have them moved, when it may not have been necessary. Mr. McCaskey suggested that they be invited to attend the work session. Mr. Ferlin asked if they should pay the invoices. Mr. Bushman noted that a moratorium was placed on any additional work at the last meeting. Road superintendent Jim Teichman asked about tree work and said he would wait for the Trustees' directive. McCaskey planned to walk the property with resident Allen Muhic. A resident was concerned about her remaining trees because the dirt was not replaced.

PARK BOARD

Jim O'Neill and Joe Herczak were present. Mr. O'Neill advised that each park board member was assigned a park. Prior to the meeting, Joe Herczak sent the Trustees information on layouts and pricing for the Scenic River trails. The trails were overgrown and hard to follow. Time was spent over the last couple month improving the trails, and working with Pete McDonald of the Western Reserve Land Conservancy to move the wet portions into dry areas wherever possible. Markers were placed on the trees to make the trails easier to follow. His estimate for materials and labor to complete the project was approximately \$20,000. He identified sixteen areas that will require a boardwalk or bridge, and gave the board the financial breakdown for each. Mrs. McMullen inquired about a NatureWorks grant and will contact the Chagrin River Watershed Partners. The estimated cost does not include construction and Mr. Herczak asked if the road department would be available to construct the modular units over the winter. He will meet with the road superintendent to discuss the project and said he would be available to supervise construction. Eagle Scout participation will be considered as long as it does not delay the project. The fire department suggested that the bridges be made wide enough for an emergency response. The project will be discussed further at the next meeting. Mr. Herczak will not be available December 13th, but said his primary purpose was to secure funding. Mr. O'Neill submitted a list of park events and dates. Mr. McCaskey was contacted about dugouts for the ball fields, and was waiting for a follow up call.

FIRE REPORT/CHIEF MARK LYNN

Fire Chief Lynn advised the department has three grants in process. The SCBA grant will not be finalized until the end of the year and payment will not be required until January. The other participating entities have been notified. The department will seek an exhaust system grant for all vehicles and a grant for a drone. The trucks have been readied for winter and salt stored up. ROAD REPORT/ SUPERINTENDENT JIM TEICHMAN

Mr. McCaskey asked the road superintendent to test the heat tapes before they were needed, and asked who would be turning them on for the winter. Mr. Teichman addressed the Aero Mark striping invoice. The discrepancy in billing was due to additional work done on Fowlers Mill Road that was not requested and a higher price because the township striped fewer roads than were quoted. The company agreed to a \$500 reduction, which Mr. Teichman thought was fair. Mr. Ferlin asked if Sherman Road could be white striped also, and Mr. Teichman advised that it was too late to do it this year. Mr. McCaskey said the Board would take it under advisement for next year. Mr. Teichman noted that the paint lasts approximately two years. Mr. Bushman asked about white delineator stakes to mark the roads for snow plowing. Mr. Teichman advised that the white stakes cost \$29 as opposed to \$2.95 for a snow plow stake. A box costs over \$400. They have used up their supplies and will buy another box to use in the most necessary places.

RESOLUTION 2016-39/EAGLE SCOUT THOMAS VAN ZEELAND

Resolution 2016-39 was made by Irene McMullen and seconded by Andy Bushman to recognize Thomas Van Zeeland of Boy Scout Troop 91 for his achievement of the Rank of Eagle Scout, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried. [As his Eagle Project, Mr. Van Zeeland made several information enhancements for the Scenic River Park. The resolution in its entirety is included on a separate page as part of the minutes.]

RONYAK ASPHALT RESURFACING CHANGE ORDER

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to approve a change order for The Asphalt Resurfacing of Various Roads RS-MUN-16 for an increase of \$235.30 to Ronyak Paving, as follows: original contract amount \$190,345.50, total additions \$2,592.80, total deducts \$2,357.50, final contract amount \$190,580.80, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

TRAPPING IN TOWNSHIP PARKS

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to grant Adam McKinney permission to trap beaver out of the nuisance areas at the parks in Munson Township, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

SERVER

Mr. Bushman has a call in to Matt Moormeier. The problem with the township's computer server does not have to be resolved until January.

NO ENGINE BRAKE SIGNS

Mrs. McMullen advised the engineer's office does not have a policy for wording for a "no engine brake" sign. She also contacted the prosecutor's office. She asked the Board to approve signs reading "No Engine Brakes" to be erected on Auburn Road at the entrance and exit of the township. The Board discussed the wording and if signs were necessary at both locations. Mr. Bushman was concerned that the county would remove the signs. Mrs. McMullen said the engineer's office approved the signs, but she would get it in writing. She believed the county would pay for the signs and put them up.

BOARD APPOINTMENTS

Mr. Bushman will contact the BZA chairman regarding the applicants for the open alternate positions.

Andy Bushman moved and Irene McMullen seconded to appoint Adriano Fiucci to the Munson Township Zoning Commission for a 5-year term ending December 31, 2021, with a unanimous vote. Motion carried.

TIME CAPSULE

The Trustees need to look at the materials collected for the time capsule before the end of the vear.

OUTSIDE MEETINGS

Mrs. Toth attended the Geauga County Township Association meeting in Bainbridge on Wednesday, November 9, 2016. Medical marijuana, the Zica Virus, public sector retirement planning, and strategic planning were discussed.

Mr. Ferlin referenced the township's land use plan and pointed out that the 19 foot plan was contradictory to the rural character of the roads. He wanted to know if the same would be done on the other roads. Mrs. McMullen asked the residents to keep in mind that we are all neighbors and part of the community. There has been a lot of ill will. Mr. McCaskey said the horizontal view has not changed. The cross sections are key. The full engineered plan will be emailed to the residents.



Thomas then produced a map and erected signs to mark the historic points of the park. His project provided 98.5 hours of service to the community.
