

Minutes of the
Munson Township
Park & Recreation Board Special Meeting
Monday, February 7, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:20pm by Bert Diehl. Dave Jirsa was present at Town Hall. John McCreery and Jim O'Neill were absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Old Business

Flea Market

The Board decided to have an Indoor Flea Market on March 12th since the covid-19 cases have been on the decline. Secretary Julie Johnston will call past vendors and put an editorial in the local newspapers. Board members decided to hold their March meeting one week earlier so they can discuss the event.

Tennis, Basketball and Pickleball Court Update

The budget to get the tennis courts resurfaced, basketball courts replaced and pickleball courts installed is approximately \$100,000. Jim Herringshaw will follow up with the vendors to find out if their pricing will remain the same as quoted in 2021. Bert Diehl suggested contacting the pickleball court vendor to get on the list for this spring. The tennis courts are approximately 20 years old and are in better shape than the basketball courts which need extensive work.

Floating Boardwalk – Scenic River

Trustee Andy Bushman filled out online applications for two different floating dock companies catalogs which are on their way.

Scoreboards for Township Park Update

Trustee Andy Bushman confirmed the order. The installer has been difficult to get in touch with. The installation date is not confirmed at this point.

Township Park – ADA Compliant Restrooms

Road/Service Superintendent Kirk Walker along with the Service Department Members will move the partitions in the restrooms to make them ADA compliant.


New Business
