



Minutes of the
Munson Township
Park & Recreation Board Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:29pm by Chair Bert Diehl. Jim O'Neill and John McCreery were present. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Minutes

John McCreery moved and Jim O'Neill seconded to approve the minutes of December 9, 2019 as written. Passed unanimously. Motion carried.

New Business

Chardon High School Senior Project

Chardon High School varsity baseball team member Ryan Bluemmel along with his team members appeared in front of the Board seeking final approval on the proposed baseball dugout benches they presented to the Trustees at their meeting on January 7, 2020. Both dugouts are in need of two (2) 10' benches each. The students are not sure if helmet racks or bat racks will be added even though the Trustees approved bat racks. The team will not be seeking donations for this project since they are receiving \$1,000.00 from the Athletic Boosters. At this point everything is on schedule for February 17, 2020 and team members anticipate building the benches off site prior to their installation in the dugouts. The CHS Varsity Team will consider the bat rack their equipment since they will bring it to each game. The senior students did not think they will be securing the benches to the floor since the Trustees did not approve that detail. Bert Diehl moved and John McCreery seconded to approve the senior project to build two (2) benches for each dugout. Passed unanimously. Motion carried.

Dave Jirsa, a Munson resident, attended the meeting expressing his interest in becoming a new Board member.

Pickleball Courts

A Munson resident sent an email to a Trustee asking that we consider adding pickleball courts to Munson Township Park since they are becoming more popular. Bert Diehl researched the idea of turning the tennis courts into pickleball courts and it would cost approximately \$700 - \$1,300 per court. The basketball courts may be a better place since the tennis courts are used more frequently. Members will continue to research and discuss next month.
