Good afternoon:

I just want to update all of our participating recycling drop off communities with great news. Our hauler **Ohio Valley Waste** (OVW) has agreed to re-label the containers and we are in the process of approving the final artwork. Thank you for being patient as we know they are faded and hard to read.

Additionally, OVW has completed the expansion of their Material Recovery Center in Mars, PA where all district collected recyclables will now be taken and sorted. We will continue to collect the same materials with the exception of cartons. Therefore, we are back to taking all plastic containers and bottles #1 through # 7 (No Styrofoam or plastic bags) , along with aluminum and steel cans, glass bottles and jars (brown, green and clear), light weight and corrugated cardboard, newspapers, magazines and office papers. Your scheduled collection days will remain the same, and as in the past most holiday service will be delayed a day.
